Founded in 1998, WxRisk.com specializes in providing the most detailed and accurate weather forecasts for Days 3 through 30, as well as seasonal forecasts for a variety of industries impacted by weather. The company also provides a popular subscription-based newsletter for the general public, which offers detailed weather forecasts and analysis for the next three weeks (The Next Three Weeks Newsletter).

With more than two decades of experience in forecasting weather for agriculture/ grain commodities in the U.S and overseas, Mr. Tolleris also specializes in providing detailed comprehensive forecasts for those overseas areas that grain traders often find difficult to obtain, including South America and Europe. His company's current and previous clients include large and mid-size commodity trading houses, energy firms, gas and propane companies and individual farmers. The company also provides climate information and risk analysis for ski resorts, vineyards, transportation, and construction companies throughout the world. WxRisk.com has become increasingly popular on social media through the Facebook and Twitter pages. The WxRisk Facebook page has around 300,000 likes and a reach of 3.5 million during major weather events in the Eastern Continental United States.

Mr. Tolleris started his professional meteorological career in 1989 working in NYC for private weather information service providers and doing weekend TV weather for WSFB TV3 Hartford CT. In 1994, he joined NWS but left in 1999 to become a stay-at-home dad and start his own business. Mr. Tolleris grew up in the Philly/NJ/NYC metro area but moved to Virginia in 1994, where he has become an established name and personality in the "lower Middle Atlantic region" of VA, NC, WV, MD, and DEL. Mr. Tolleris served in the Navy for 6 years in Naval Intelligence and is a diehard Philadelphia Phillies fan and a Civil war nut, who thinks highly of General Ulysses S Grant, Teddy Roosevelt, and Nassim Taleb.
